

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BY AND BETWEEN THE
CALIFORNIA STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY
AND

UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE, FOREST SERVICE REGION V

September 27, 1992

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is entered into by and between the CALIFORNIA STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY (Board), and the UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE, FOREST SERVICE (USFS), Region V, for the purpose of clarifying the role of the Registered Professional Forester as it relates to the management of California's federally owned wildlands, and to provide guidance on how to deal with situations where federal and state authority overlap as it relates to the implementation of the Professional Foresters Law (PRC 750 et seq.).
